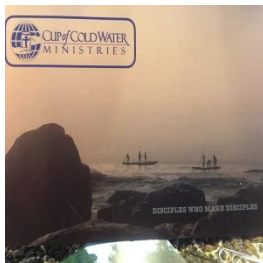

- **Celebration of Communion** will be on Trinity Sunday, June 11.



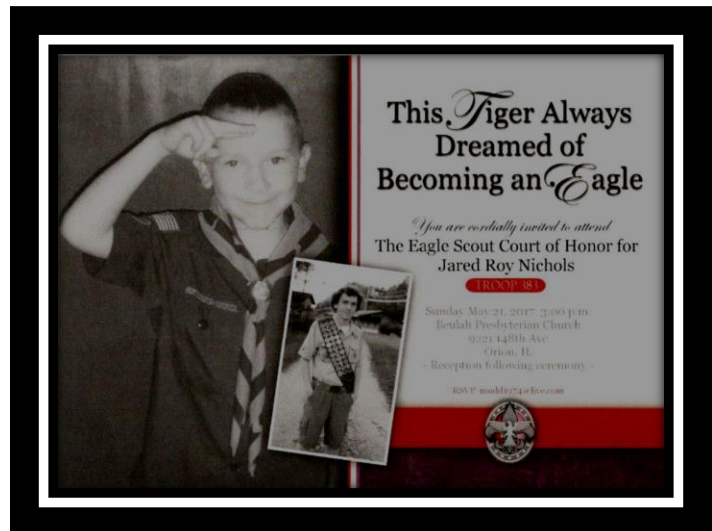

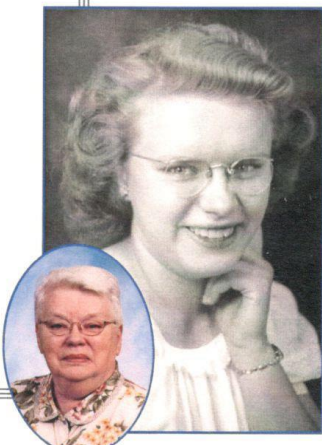
