Join us for the Annual **Jerry Sheldon Memorial Pancake Breakfast** following worship hosted by Congo Life Committee. There will be **no Sunday School**. The children are invited to an Easter Egg hunt following breakfast. **\*\*One Great Hour of Sharing:** The church is the Holy Spirit’s transforming power emanating into the world sharing the compassion, justice, love and peace of Christ. Presbyterians join the movement of the Spirit into every corner of the Earth through the church-wide One Great Hour of Sharing. There are three focus areas to better the world

1. PRESBYTERIAN DISASTER ASSISTANCE (PDA) Works along-side communities as they recover and find hope after the devastation of natural or human-caused disasters, and support for refugees.
  - o Receives 32% of funds raised.
2. PRESBYTERIAN HUNGER PROGRAM (PHP)
  - o Takes action to alleviate hunger, care for creation, and the systemic causes of poverty so all may be fed.
  - o Receives 36% of funds raised.
3. SELF-DEVELOPMENT OF PEOPLE (SDOP)
  - o Invests in communities responding to their experiences of oppression, poverty and injustice & educates Presbyterians about the impact of these issues.
  - o Receives 32% of funds raised.
