- **Peanut Brittle Fund Raiser** The Mission Committee will again be selling home-made peanut brittle to raise funds for their 2019-2020 Mission Projects. The proceeds are used to purchase boots for our Heads to Toes project and to help provide funds for our other mission projects throughout the year. The price is \$15 for a 1 lb. package, and \$8 for a ½ lb. pkg. Delivery will be on Sun Nov 24 and Sun Dec 15. Please contact Wanda Cross to order your peanut brittle.
