#### **Church Finances**

The Session has met to discuss the church's finances as we approach the end of the year.

They attempted to estimate what our actual expense at the end of the year will be and what our giving will end up to be.

One decision that was made was to account for the sealing and striping of the parking lot as an expense from the long term savings of the church rather than being an obligation for this year's budget. After that, when comparing what we think the expenses will be to what we think the income will be, we project a short fall of \$3,881.
