Note: There will NOT be a Worship Service at Beulah that day.

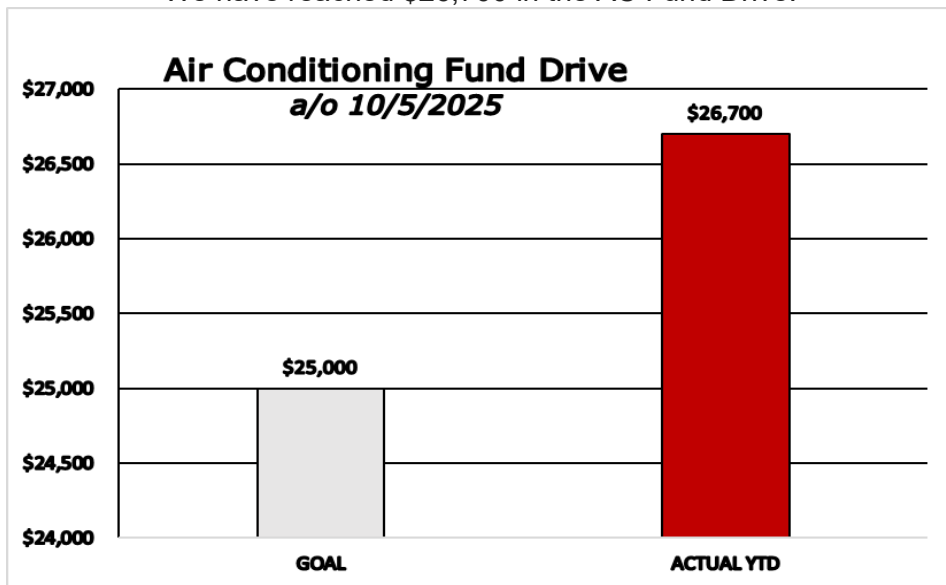
After Worship there will be a Scottish festival to enjoy.
